Participants acknowledge that they are responsible for their own personal belongings and that Total Recreation NT Inc. accepts no responsibility for the loss, theft or damage of any personal property.

- Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult.
- Participants must not wear headphones or use mobile phones in any manner that prevents them from remaining aware of their surroundings.
- First Aid services will be available at the start finish line.
- Participants must behave respectfully towards other participants, volunteers and members of the public. The event organisers reserve the right to remove any participant whose behaviour is considered unsafe or inappropriate.
